We searched everywhere - under the _____, behind the _____, and even inside the _____ parked in the driveway. No bunny.

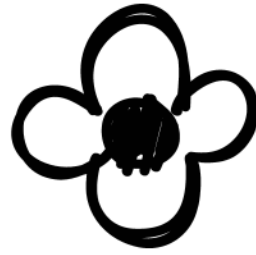

What's an adjective?

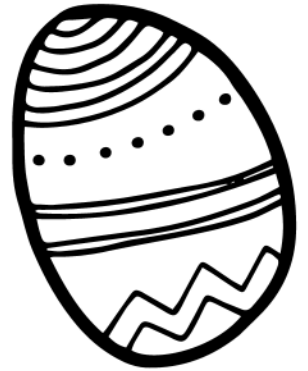
A word that describes something.

A person, place, or thing.

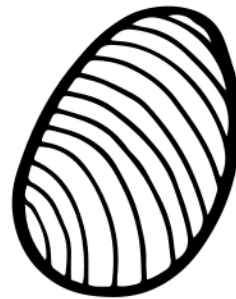
Example: dog, park, cookie.

More than one person, place, or thing.

Example: dogs, parks, cookies.



What's a verb?

An action word.

Example: run, jump, sing.

What's a verb ending in "ing"?

An action word that shows something is happening right now.

Example: running, jumping, singing

What's a past tense verb?

An action word that shows something has already happened.

Example: ran, jumped, sang.
